- It provides a safe environment for workers to report or discuss breaches of conduct without recrimination.
- Transparency and consistency in all business decision making.
- Compliance with the Fair Work Act 2009.

All workers are encouraged to raise any concerns regarding potential breaches of this policy to either their supervisor or management.
