

FATIGUE MANAGEMENT POLICY

Fleurieu Cranes Pty Ltd recognises fatigue as a major hazard in our operational undertakings. We are committed to ensuring that our workers are provided the processes and knowledge to avoid occurrences and any impacts thereafter.

Fatigue may be caused by a number of factors both internal and external. It is the responsibility of all workers to work together to manage the causes of fatigue to optimise the safety of our work environment.

Fleurieu Cranes shall ensure that:

- All personnel are trained to recognise the causes and related symptoms of fatigue.
- All personnel feel empowered to stop work if they are concerned that fatigue may be preventing them from working safely.
- Plans are in place to prevent fatigue where practicable, and that controls are implemented to manage the situation should fatigue occur.
- Workers are encouraged to discuss with supervisors and managers, any issues which may lead to increased levels of fatigue.

Fleurieu Cranes shall continue to promoting fatigue awareness and ensure fatigue management is continually considered when planning work schedules.
